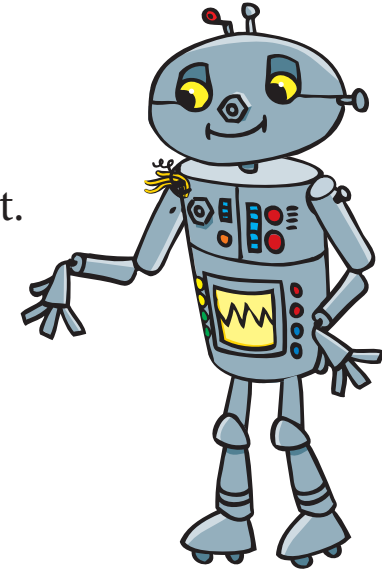

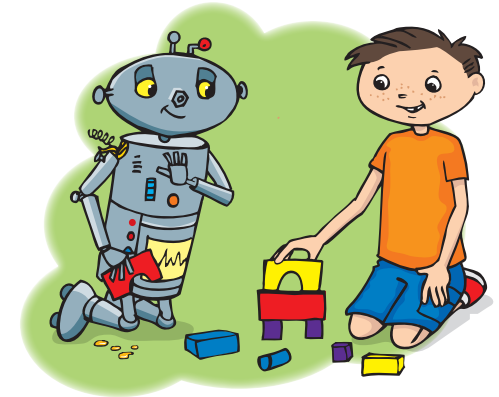

He is Lolly's friend.



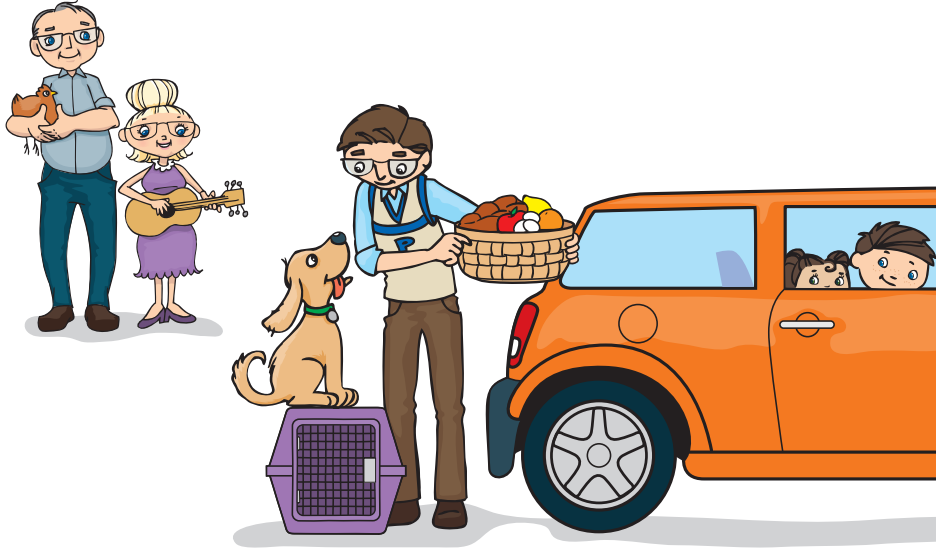

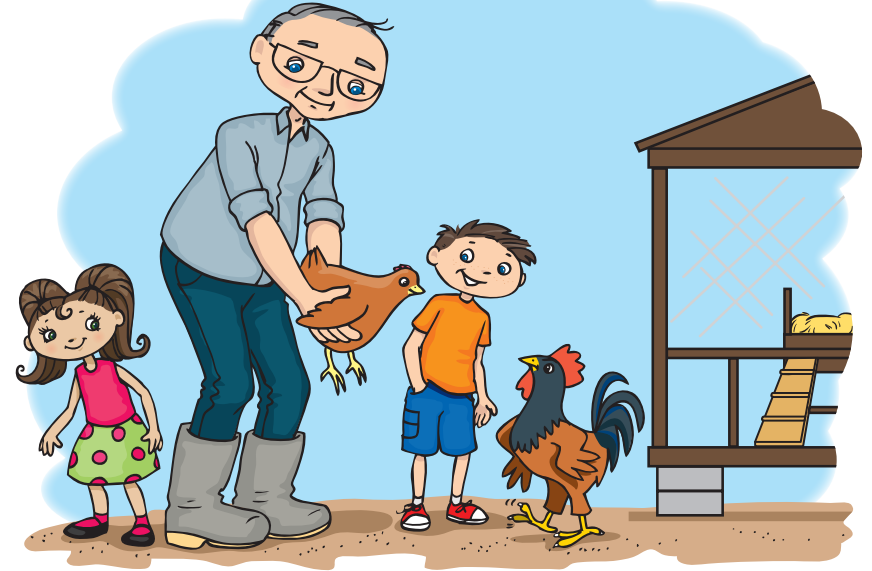

The P family go to visit Grandma and Grandpa P on the Little Farm.



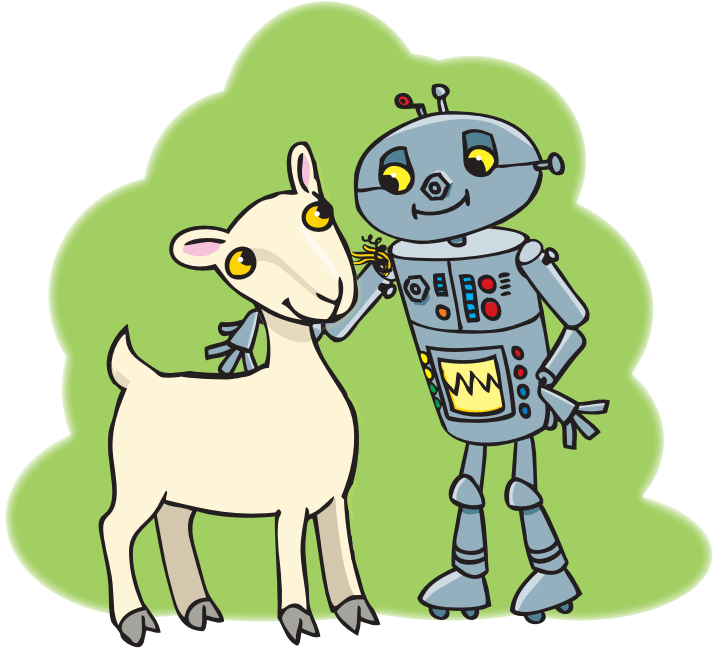
There are lots of animals on the farm and many jobs to do.

with the Feed Pail*

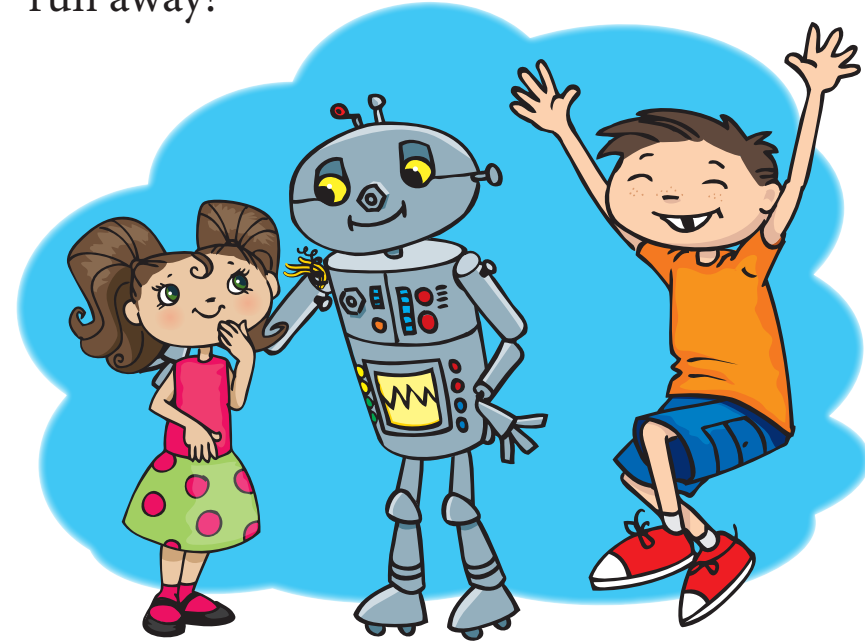


When Sam arrived that day at The Little Farm with The Pretend Family, he heard Dolly Goat calling. ‘I need your help!’

‘What a great idea!’ exclaimed Lolly.

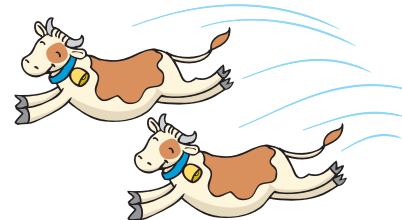

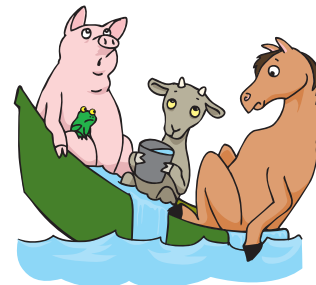

*Listen to the "Flying Cows" Song*

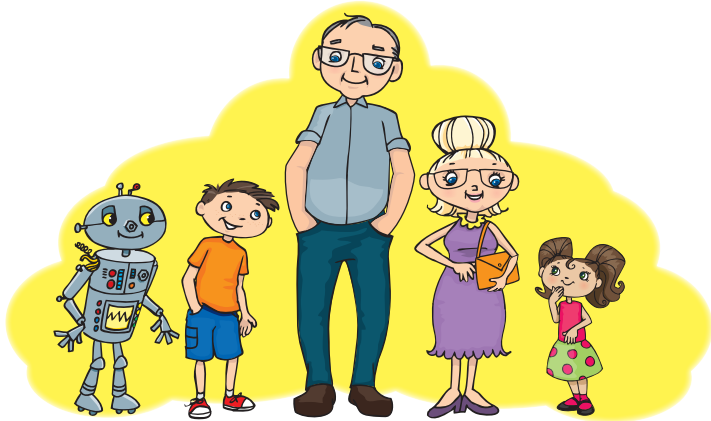
The kids danced with excitement when they arrived at the zoo.



‘We want to see the lions’ cried Polly.

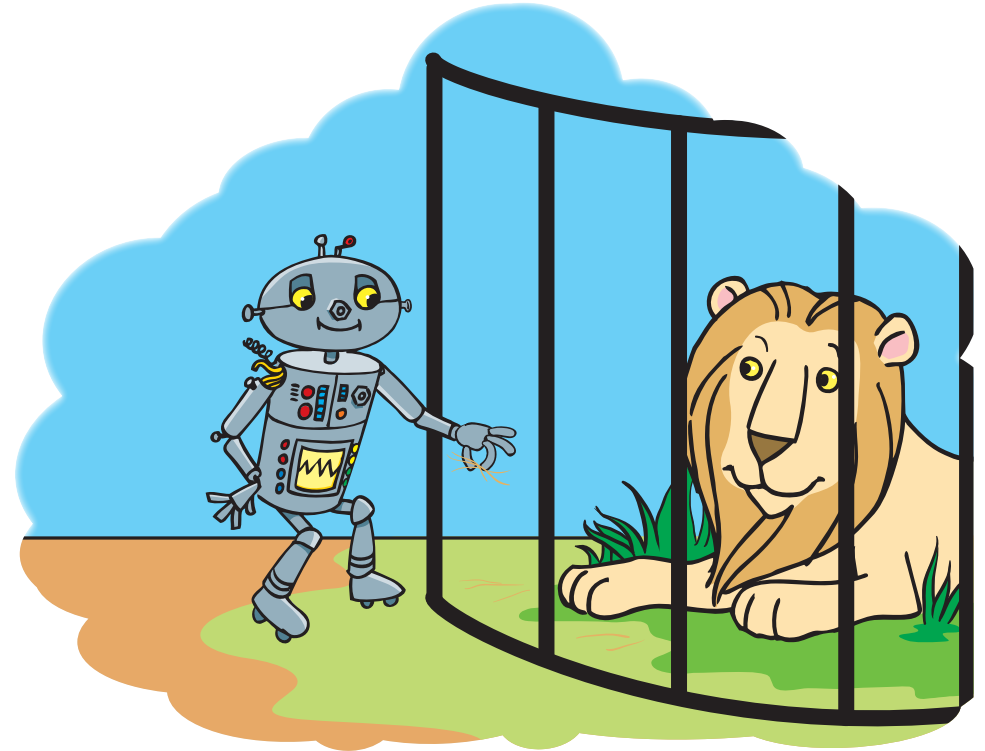
‘We will get to them soon,’ said Grandpa, ‘Let’s go and see the monkeys first’.

‘Oh no, Grandpa’ said Lolly, ‘we must see the lions first’. ‘But I have to go Potty’ said Polly.



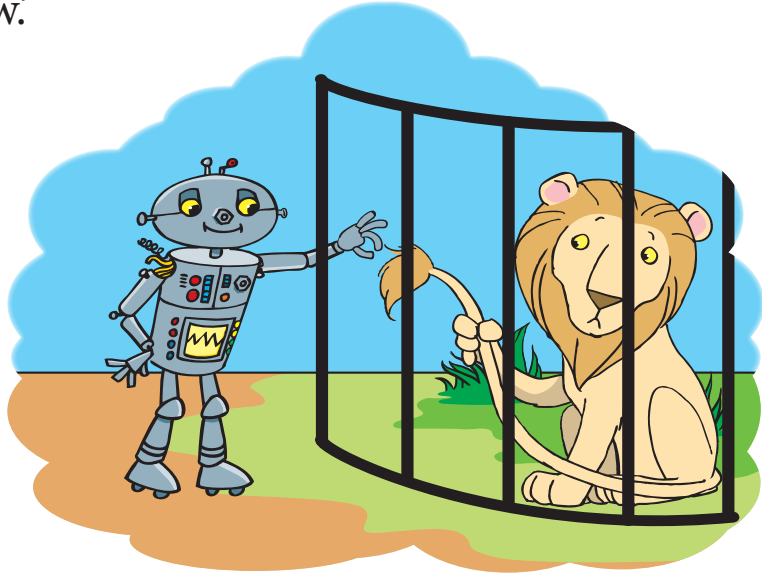
*Listen to “The Potty Song” as Grandma takes Polly and Lolly to the bathroom!*

Finally they got to the Lion’s cage. Sam slowly put his good arm through the rails and grabbed some stray lion hairs. Leo, the lion growled.



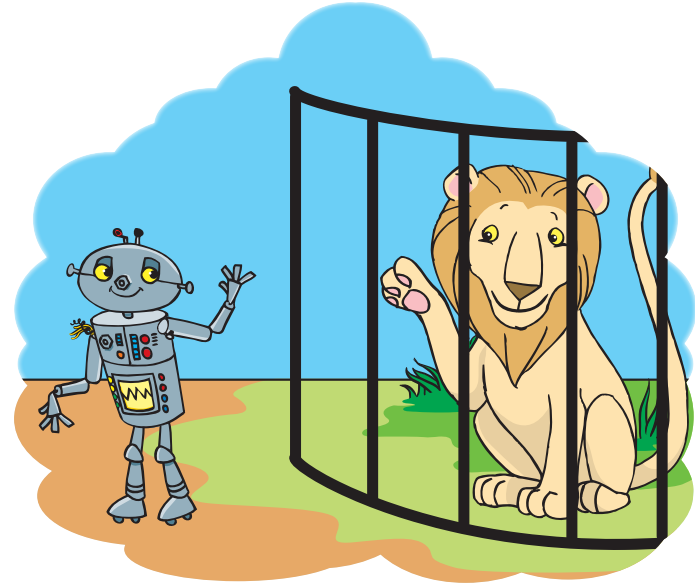
‘Oh phooey,’ said Sam, ‘you are just an old sour-puss. You growl just to scare the kids; I know you are just a big pussycat.’

When they were back at the farm, Lolly dropped something onto the path. ‘What are you doing, Lolly?’ Grandpa asked. But Lolly was too busy to answer.

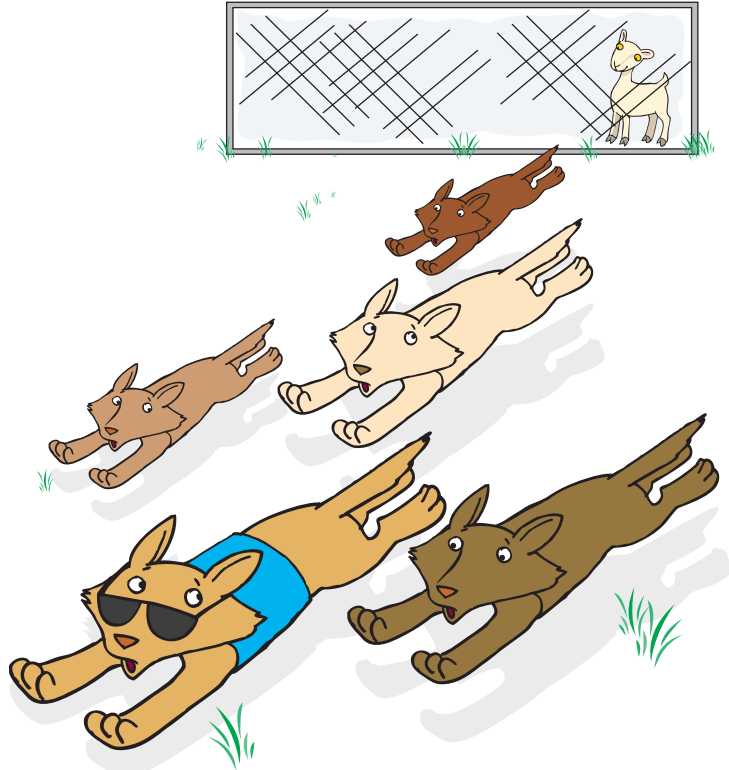

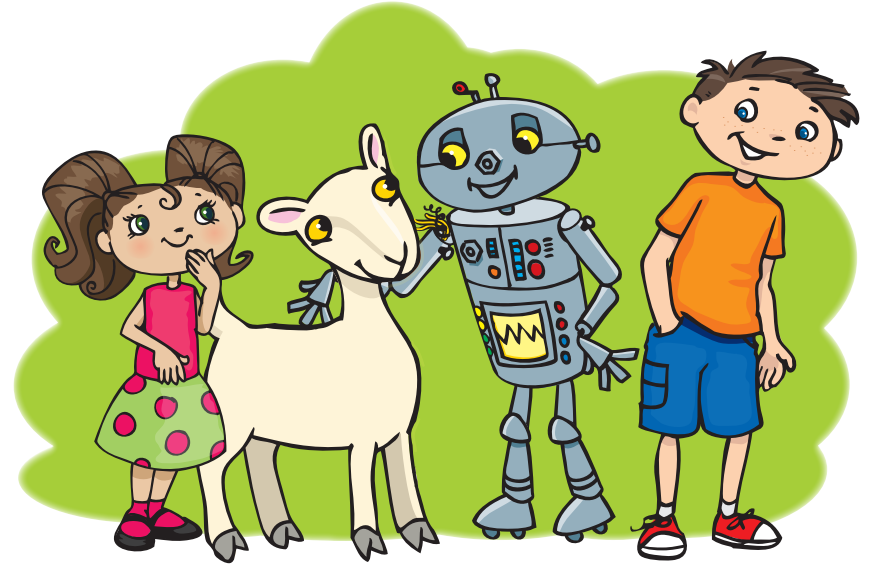
*Listen to the song ‘Monsters in My Room’*
